On February 22, 1922, he was appointed full head from Germia when he was named Co-Adjutor Archbishop of Sydney, Australia. He was consecrated on May 28. In August, on his way to Australia, he stopped in Rome and stayed at Irish College. He had an audience with Pope Pao XI, in which they spoke German. In Sydney, Dr. Sheehan Vivias in a two -story Italian house at the corner of Broughton RD and Meredith St, Homebush. As Archbishop coad, he distinguished himself by his culture, inexhaustible piety and gentle kindness of him. In 1924, he relaunched the quarterly magazine, the Catholic Registry of Australasia, and became a regular taxpayer, while practically acted as his editor. He maintained the Episcopal Office in Sydney until his resignation in 1937 after the apostolic delegate had made it clear, the panic archbishop, which, because he was Irish, would not happen to Dr. Kelly as Archbishop from Sydney. In the announcement of the resignation of Dr. Sheehan, it was probably the Archbishop Mannix de Melbourne, who was the author of the public letter of the bishops and the archbishops of Australia, saying, the news of his resignation ... He filled us all With sadness and consternation, because we realize that your march is an irreparable passion for the Church in Australia a true tragedy. When he retired to Ireland, Archbishop Sheehan Vivias in Dublín, in the parents of the holy spur, but often visited the ring, County Waterford (four miles from Dungarvan), where he once wore his vacation among the fishing people Allé . It was in the ring that he had learned for the first time Irish of an old woman, and in 1906 he had co - founded an Irish university, which is still thriving today. Although he had not spoken Irish in his childhood, he became competent in him and wrote six works in Ireland, including language studies. Dr. Sheehan wrote two other books of religious instruction, a book of religion of a child (1934), and a simple course of religion (1937). He had a great interest in plants-lore and botany and co-authored a book about that subject of nearly 500,000 copies of de Classical high school texts were printed and used to teach the Faith to generations of English-speaking Catholics around the world for more than four decades.
